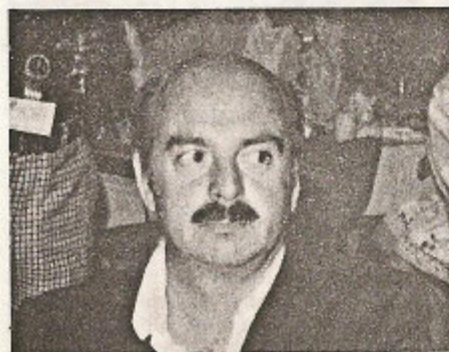

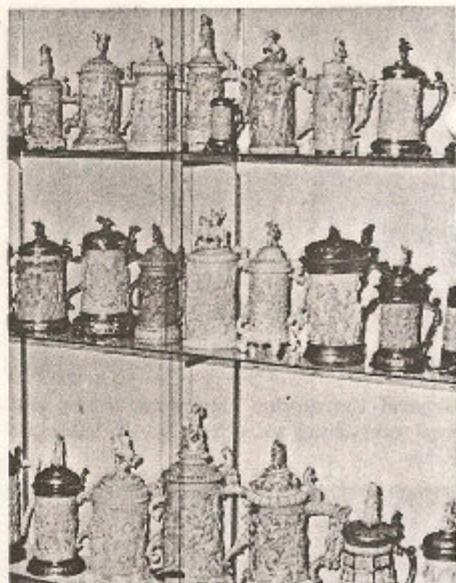

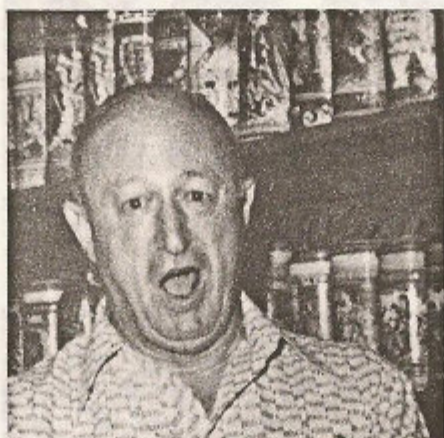

July 28, 1976

The Fourth Annual Board Meeting was called order by our Chairman, Norm Medoy, at 1:30 p.m. The following were present:

The chairman announced that it was getting late, so that we would have to start without the other board members.

The Minutes of the Third Board Meeting has been sent to all the officers and Board Members. Norm Medow asked if there were any corrections or deletions.

Jack Heimann pointed out that the name Saramarte was spelled wrong. It should be: C E R A M A R T E. It is on page 2, under Old Business, the last sentence "The money could be sent to Saramarte or use the money as a cushion for the next convention."

On Page 4, where it said 4 inches for packages of steins, delete "not."

Also on Page 2, the word "descrepancy" should be Difference. The third paragraph on Page 5 should be crossed out.

Another correction was on Page 9, where "blanks" should read "steins," and the following be added: and provide security.

Jack Lowenstein moved that the minutes be accepted as corrected. The motion was seconded by Al Hoch and the motion carried.

Vera Christy said that there was an audit for 1973, 74, and 75.
