Minutes of Board Meeting

August 1, 1984 Trier, West Germany

The twelfth Annual Board meeting of Stein Collectors International was called to order at 4:10 P.M. by Board Chairman, Les Whitham.

Members not in attendance were: Clarke, Post; Kottke, and Gray. Carol Fox represented Gambrinus and Therese Thomas -- Mettlach Steinzeug Sammlers. Appointed members of the Board: Parliamentarian -- Dezso Ladanyi and Convention Coördinator Ridge Scott were also present.

2. Parliamentarian Dezso Ladanyi was called on to outline the procedures to be used throughout the meeting. A shorter more relaxed version of rules was suggested by Ladanyi to expedite business.

3. Inasmuch as the Minutes of the 1983 Board Meeting had been distributed to all members with the Meeting Agenda by Secretary Hill prior to the meeting, the Board accepted the 1983 Minutes without a reading.

4. In the absence of Treasurer Pat Clarke, the Treasurer's Report was delivered by Jack Lowenstein. As of June 30, 1984 SCI showed a cash balance of \$60,312.32 with no bills outstanding. The fiscal report for 1983 showed a net gain of \$8,640. -- this was due primarily to a 1983 Convention profit of \$7,253. Interest income was off a bit in 1983 due to a decline in interest rates. After a motion by George Misch, the Board voted to accept the report as read.

5. Committee Reports:

A. Credential Committee Chairman Ron Fox's list of members had previously been circulated as a roll sheet by Secretary Hill. This having been accomplished there was no need for further commentary by Chairman Fox.

B. The Jack Heimann Service Award Committee headed by Les Whitham, recommended that no award be granted this year. Of those nominated, the committee felt that these nominees were more likely candidates for Master Steinologist. Chairman Whitham encouraged Executive Director Jack Lowenstein to list the qualifications for the Jack Heimann Service Award in future issues of Prosit, thus encouraging new nominations from the membership.
