

News Flash for the 2021 Convention

The site has been chosen for the Friday, October 8, 2021 Afternoon Tea. We now have the Afternoon Tea set! It will be at **The Inn at Montchanin Village & Spa**, which is listed on the National Historic Register and was once a part of the Winterthur Estate. It was named for Alexandria de Montchanin, grandmother of the founder of the DuPont Company.

In eleven carefully restored buildings dating from 1799, there are 28 richly furnished guest rooms/suites appointed with period and reproduction furniture and marble baths

It will be held in the upstairs room of what was once the village blacksmith shop, and today is the **Krazy Kat's Restaurant**. An elegantly private dining-room known as the **Crow's Nest** will be the venue for our "Afternoon Tea". So ladies bring your hats and pretty dresses, gents wear your finest outfit to be dressed for the tea. As seating is limited for up to 40 guests.
